Seeking nominations for 7 trustees Ngaati Te Ata Claims Support Whaanau Charitable Trust on behalf of Ngaati Te Ata Waiohau iwi seeks to prepare to enter into negotiations with the Crown for the comprehensive and final settlement of all remaining individual and collective historical claims of Ngaati Te Ata Waiohau. To achieve this, we require skilled individuals to act on behalf of and be accountable to Ngaati Te Ata Waiohau iwi and whaanau. The key roles we need people for include; Trustees (7 people) The Ngaati Te Ata Claims Support Whaanau Charitable Trust will be responsible for assessing the nominees against the set criteria. Successful nominees will be required to attend a waananga before the Mandating Hui aa-iwi on Saturday, 22 March 2026. TRUSTEE A person eligible to be nominated must: - Be aged over 18 years - Be registered to Ngaati Te Ata Waiohau - Be a direct descendant of the union between Te Ata i Reehia and Tapaue or be a whaangai to Ngaati Te Ata Waiohau. - Attend a Nominee Waananga in March 2026, before the elections. A person is ineligible to be appointed or to continue to serve as a Trustee if that person: Bankruptcy: Is an undischarged bankrupt or has, within the last five years, been adjudged bankrupt under the Insolvency Act 2006. Dishonesty Convictions: Has been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty (as defined in section 2(1) of the Crimes Act 1961) or an offence under section 382 of the Companies Act 1993, unless that person is an eligible individual under the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004. Removal as Trustee: Has been removed as a trustee by order of a Court (under the Trusts Act 2019 or predecessor legislation) on the grounds of breach of trust, lack of competence, or failure to carry out the duties of a trustee satisfactorily. Lack of Capacity: Lacks capacity as defined in section 6 of the Trusts Act 2019, or is subject to a property order or personal order made under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988. Conflict of Interest (Settlement Process): Holds an existing role as a negotiator or trustee with another claimant (whanaunga) iwi within the Taamaki Makaurau / Waikato settlement process that results in a conflict of interest.
